On 10 March, Margaret Smith organised tickets for a performance by the Canberra Repertory Company in Theatre 3 for *Oh*, *What a lovely War!* The audience enjoyed the performance and the ambiance of the theatre.

Building 115 - 1RS (Number 1 Receiving Station)

On 16 March, Sue Mathams, Defence Estate and Infrastructure Group contacted the President of WRANS ACT to advise building 115 (Number 1 Receiving station) will be demolished in the near future because it is unsafe (asbestos etc.). The cost to repair the building could not be supported. However, building 115 is identified with heritage values and therefore Defence is required to undertake a heritage impact assessment (HIA) to be compliant with Commonwealth legislation (EPBC Act).

One recommendation of the HIA is to develop an interpretation of building 115 and stakeholders agreed to refurbish the Gate House and use it as the interpretive/educational signage/information about building 115.

The focus of the project is on three main areas:

- HMAS *Harman's* establishment
- Role in World War II, and
- Communicators and the Women's Royal Australian Naval Service (WRANS).

A consultant will be engaged to develop the display in the Gate House. WRANS – Naval Women's Association (ACT) was invited to provide a point of contact (POC) to liaise with the consultant and members to ensure the WRANS story is told. Kerry Holmes (Wallis) is the POC and will contact members to provide further information as required. I suggested the Electrical Technical Communications (ETC) 'Greenies' be contacted as they also worked in building 115.

I would like to express my thanks to all the members who were willing to help with the project.

Cowra bus trip





War Widows Field of the Remembrance

On 20 April, Rae Milfill (Cooper) will represent the WRANS – Naval Women's Association (ACT) and lay the Association Cross during the War Widows Field of Remembrance ANZAC Day Commemorative Service at the El Alamein Village in Lyneham.

ANZAC Day march

On 12 February, during our Annual General Meeting, it was agreed we would support '*By the Left*' initiative on ANZAC day meaning WRANS – Naval Women's Association (ACT) will march with the women's Veterans contingent. The Order of the March is all women Veterans will march as the 2nd Veteran contingent behind the Army Apprentices, but 5th in Order of March (behind the Official Party, flag bearers etc).

Order of March

Form up by 1000 hours for a 1030 march off. The women's contingent will meet in the vicinity of the Australian Army National Memorial. Contingents will gather on the red gravel parade area in between the planter boxes. The WRANS, WRAAC and WRAAF Association banners will be visible.

The three Presidents will command their own group, in front of the women's contingent. As the senior service WRANS – Naval Women's Association (ACT) will lead the women's contingent and will march in four columns.

The command 'EYES RIGHT' will be given when passing the Reviewing Officer. This will be followed by 'EYES FRONT'. The command may be difficult to hear so members are asked to ensure that they acknowledge the Reviewing Officer when passing their immediate front.

Dress of the day is smart dress or trousers in black or navy with a white shirt and white hat if you have one. Serving members may wear uniform if permission is granted by their Commanding Officer.

Some Pharmacies are charging discounted scripts at \$5.40 each, be aware if you take the discounted price you will need to accrue **\$388.80 (72 scripts)** to reach the Safety Net,

^{*} Always check with your GP, as this list changes from time to time. (You could have been paying full price for any of these items without realising you could have them on a prescription, thereby reaching the Safety Net of \$384.00 sooner. Remember after your 60 prescriptions per annum, at \$6.40 each your prescriptions are free.)
